INSTRUCTIONS

YOUNG ARTIST COMPETITION

The **Young Artist Solo Repertoire Competition** is open to any flutist who will be 30 years of age *or younger* at the time of the competition, *i.e.*, those born after April 1976.

Four winners will be selected to perform a piece of your choosing for the final competition.

Audition selection - Select *one* of the following pieces for unaccompanied flute:

Debussy: *Syrinx*
Ibert: *Piece for flute solo*
Muczynski: *3 Preludes, Opus 18 (any two)*

Procedures and Guidelines for YOUNG ARTIST COMPETITION:

- \$35 Non-refundable Application fee (*includes* Registration to the entire Flute Festival day).
- Applicant will submit a *high bias* tape or CD. (MD minidisks will not be accepted.)
- There must be no personal identification on the tape/CD or box.
- Recordings must be UNEDITED and will not be returned.
- Tape/CD must be sent by U.S. regular mail; no certified mail, please.
- Tape/CD must be *postmarked* by **March 26, 2007**.
- Winners will be notified by e-mail/phone on **April 1, 2007**. Judges' decisions are final.

Winners MUST provide their own accompanists (*if needed*) for the final round of the Young Artists Competition. *Pianist fees are the responsibility of the flutist.*

MASTER CLASSES & CLINICS

Master Classes are open to flutists of all ages. No audition is necessary. Selection will be based on space, piece and date of application. Applicants not selected for a master class may participate in a festival clinic.

There are **NO AGE LIMITS**. Up to four flutists will be selected to perform a piece of their choice in a master class:

- Baroque (open to performers of traverso and modern flutes),
- Piccolo, or
- General Flute.

Festival Clinics are open to solo flutists, small ensembles, and chamber groups. Flutists may perform any piece of their choice for clinicians who will provide critiques and evaluations, either verbal or written, of the performances. These educational clinics are not rated.

Master Classes & Clinic Procedures and Guidelines:

- Non-refundable application fee of \$20 for each performer (includes *Festival Registration*).
- Application should be postmarked by **April 1st, 2007**.
- Flutists must provide their own accompanist (*if needed*).
- Once performance times are designated, they may not be changed.
- Performers should arrive at their performance rooms *at least* 15 minutes before the designated time.

Participants MUST provide their own accompanists (*if needed*). *Pianist fees are the responsibility of the flutist.*
