**YOUNG ARTIST COMPETITION**

The Young Artist Solo Repertoire Competition is open to any flutist who will be 30 years of age *or younger* at the time of the competition, *i.e.*, those born after March 19, 1976.

Four winners will be selected to perform a piece of their choice for the final competition. Four runner's up will be selected to perform in a master class.

**Audition selection:** Contestant's choice of two movements of from *Acht Stucke* by Hindemith.  
See guidelines below.

**ADULT MASTERCLASS COMPETITIONS**

---

The Adult Solo Repertoire Masterclass Competition is open to all adult flutists. There is **NO AGE LIMIT**.

Up to four winners will be selected to perform a piece of their choice in a masterclass.

**Audition selection:** *Selection of your choice.* See guidelines below.

**Procedures and Guidelines for Young Artists Competition and Adult Masterclass:**

- Non-refundable Application fee of \$30 (*includes Flute Festival Registration*).
- Applicant will submit a *high bias* tape or CD. (MD minidisks will not be accepted.)
- There must be no personal identification on the tape/CD or box.
- Recordings must be UNEDITED.
- Tapes/CDs must be sent by U.S. regular mail; no certified mail, please.
- Tape/CDs must be *postmarked* by **April 1st, 2006**.
- Tapes/CDs will be not be returned.
- Winners will be notified by e-mail/phone no later than **April 10th, 2006**. Judges' decisions are final.
- Winners **MUST** provide their own accompanists (*if needed*) for the final round of the Young Artists Competition and for the Adult Master Class Competitions.

**SOLO AND ENSEMBLE FLUTE FESTIVAL CLINICS**

Flute Festival *Clinics* are open to all flutists. Flutists will perform any piece of their choice for clinicians who will provide critiques and evaluations, either verbal or written, of the performances. These clinics are for educational purposes and not rated, although the clinicians may select an *Outstanding Performer* who may elect to perform in the *Gala Concert*.

**Solo or Ensemble Flute Clinic Procedures and Guidelines:**

- Non-refundable application fee of \$10 plus \$5 for each additional ensemble performer.
- Application Deadline: postmarked by **April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006**.
- Flutists may provide their own accompanist. If selected as an *Outstanding Performer*, flutists **MUST** provide their own accompanist for the *Gala Concert*.
- Once performance times are designated, they may not be changed.
- Performers should arrive at their performance rooms *at least* 15 minutes before the designated time.
